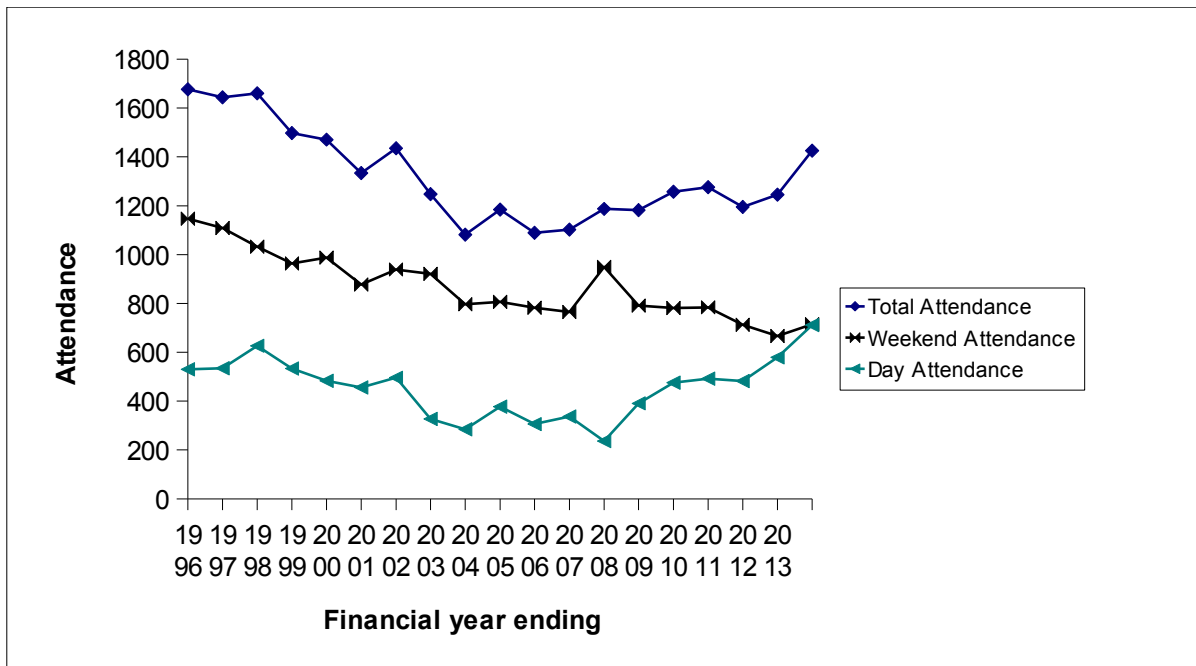
It's good to see the high number of walks out. **Thank-you leaders.**

Only 15% of members led trips – food for thought!

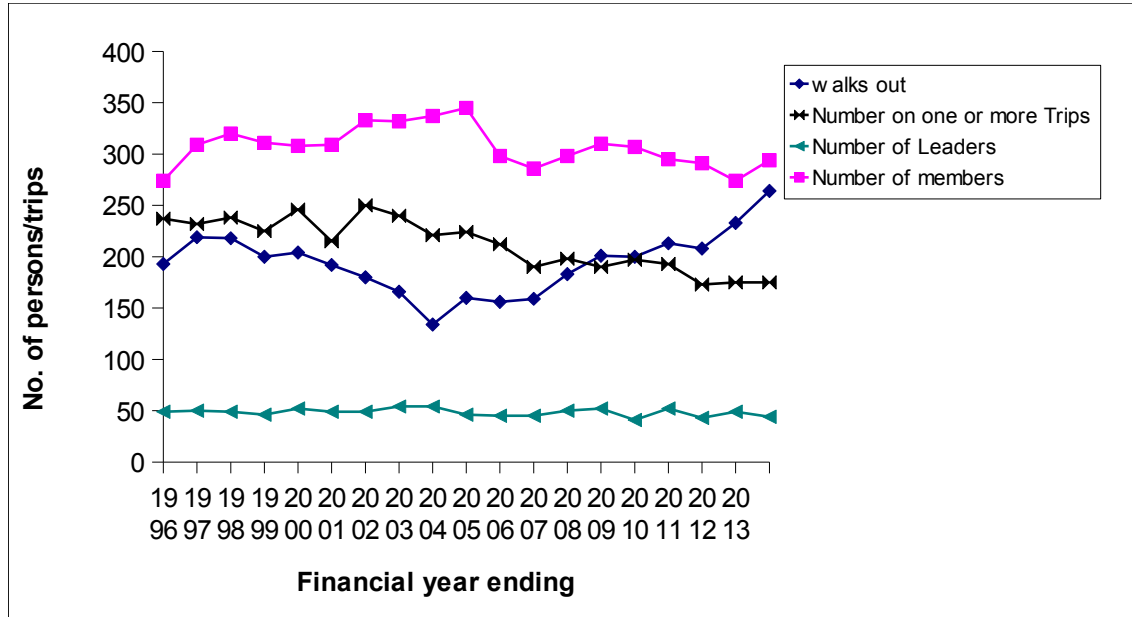
Last year continued to see an increase in the number of day trips, but no decrease in weekend trips.
